Scott Lineberry began at Ultimate Kids (Tumblebees), in 1997 as a volunteer assistant coach for the trampoline and tumbling team. In 2002 he joined Tumblebees' founder Sally Newton and two others as partners. Before joining Tumblebees as a partner, Scott worked in a family business and as an executive in a publicly traded company.

Scott holds with a double Ph.D. in the field of Sport Psychology. He is founder and president of The Center for Life and Performance, a sport development counseling and consulting practice for athletes, arts performances, first responders and their families. Scott is Safe Sport certified and is coach certified in gymnastics and diving.

Scott was a former high school, collegiate, and senior national diver. He has coached diving and trampoline/double mini-trampoline (DMT) for over 45 years. He has coached numerous national medalists and champions, National Team members, and international medalists in trampoline and DMT. Scott has coached divers to elite national finals and who competed in Olympic trials and NCAA finals.

Scott's coaching philosophy: Each athlete needs to learn ownership of their own sport development and journey with the priority of character development. A coach's role is to provide opportunities and boundaries for character and sport development. There are few things more rewarding than watching a young athlete discover that they are more than what they perceive themselves as.
